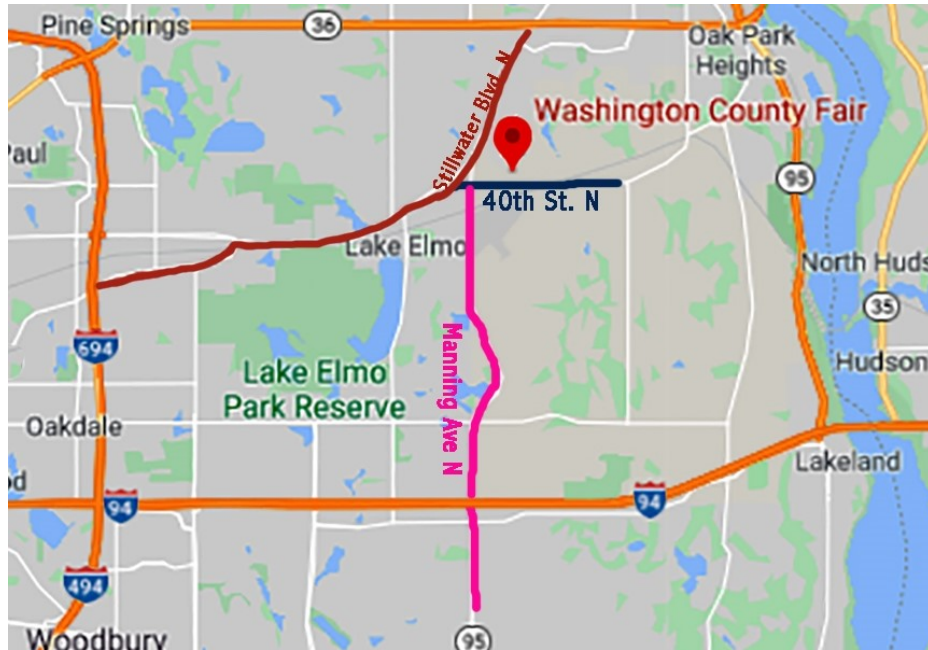

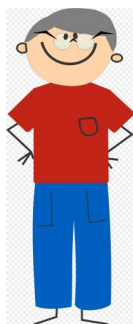
IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS - COVID-19 INFORMATION
